








Persistence & Graduation

Between 2011 and 2015, the number of first time, full-time undergraduate students returning for their first fall semester after their original enrollment has increased.






On average, it takes first-time undergraduates **4.2** calendar years to earn a degree.

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
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

Graduation Rates by Momentum Rates




Under 15 Credits vs 15 & Over Credits, First-Year, Fall Semester






Proportion of 100/200 Level Courses Offered by Number of Credits, Fall Semester






